Santa's Workshop Funds are to be used for **specific projects**, not to be used for general funds. A representative of your organization should be ready to attend our **September 16th** meeting (6:00 p.m., Fellowship Hall of **First Presbyterian Church**, 20 North Dixie Avenue, Cookeville) to give a **one and a half minute** presentation to our club **about this project and your organization**. You will still be eligible for funds if a representative is unable to attend, but these presentations are very helpful for our members to make an informed decision about the distribution of Santa's Workshop funds.

We encourage organizations to apply whether or not they have received funding in the past. Each CJWC member will vote on the project(s) they wish to support with Santa's Workshop Funds. The Funds Committee will contact your organization to let you know whether or not you will receive funding from the 2021 Santa's Workshop. If selected, you will be given the opportunity to promote your organization at Santa's Workshop along with other recipients. More details will be given at the time of notification.

We will be unable to know how much funding your organization will receive until we have completed all paperwork associated with the 2021 Santa's Workshop. **We anticipate being able to distribute Santa's Workshop funds in December 2021.** A representative of your organization will be asked to attend the distribution of funds so that we may place information about the project and our support in the Herald-Citizen newspaper.
